Terroristic Threat

On April 10, 2022 around 1816 hours Deputy Bell responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn (Youth Homes) in reference to Terroristic Threatening. Upon Deputy Bell's arrival contact was made with Qualified Behavior Health Professionals Bill Givens and Bobby Bradley. Mr. Given stated Juvenile got upset after being asked to return the remote control to the television due to him watching inappropriate videos. When staff went to retrieve the remote control Mr. Givens stated threatened to spit in his face and hit him in the head with a rock. Mr. Givens also stated walked up to him and knocked his hat off of his head.

Mr. Bradley who witnessed the incident stated was watching inappropriate videos YouTube and Mr. Given asked for the remote and refused to give Mr. Givens the remote. Mr. Bradley stated Mr. Givens told since you don't want to give me the remote I'll just turn off the television. Mr. Bradley stated when Mr. Givens went to turn off the TV stood up and said "well I ain't given you the remote". Mr. Bradley stated that's when he got involved and was talking to and Mr. Given stated for to give the remote to Mr. Bobby. Afterward Mr. Bradley stated turned and bumped into Mr. Givens and stated to him "I'll hit your ass right now". Mr. Bradley stated Mr. Givens backed away from and came up toward the kitchen area. Mr. Bradley stated walked to the area were Mr. Givens was and begin to walk around making derogatory statements towards Mr. Givens stating "fuck your dead mother, I'll spit on you and I'll go outside and get a rock and hit you in the head like I did Mr. Davis." Mr. Bradley stated at that moment they call the Sheriff Office.

Next Deputy Bell made contact with who stated he was watching and he put it on a rap video that has profanity in it and Mr. Givens told him he could not watch videos with profanity. stated he didn't know the video had profanity in it but he just kept watching because he was being stupid and that's how he be sometimes. stated Mr. Givens asked him to change the channel and he stated no. stated Mr. Givens walked over to him and tried to take the remote from him and he stated to Mr. Givens take it, but Mr. Givens didn't take the remote and they got into an argument and he gave the remote to Mr. Bobby.

stated he tried talking to Mr. Givens, but he just ignored him and tried to talk over him. stated this angered him and he pushed Mr. Givens cap off of his head. stated he tried to restrain himself to keep the incident from escalating and being physical because he did not want to go back the juvenile detention. Deputy Bell asked if he threatened to hit Mr. Givens in the head with a rock and he stated he did but

he didn't mean it. He just says stuff out of the blue when he gets mad and he needs anger management treatment to help him deal with his anger. Deputy Bell made phone contact with juvenile intake officer Stacy Pomeroy and advised her of the incident. Officer Pomeroy stated to cite _____ for the incident. _____ was cited for Terroristic threatening 2nd and given a court date of May 5th at 0900.
