Battery

On 5/17/2022, Deputy Walker responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a Battery.

Upon arrival, Deputy Walker made contact with Rhonerick Johnson. Johnson stated that he is the health care provider at the youth home. Johnson stated that he asked [redacted] to move to his assigned seat. Johnson stated that he and [redacted] had a brief verbal altercation and shortly after [redacted] moved seats. Johnson stated that approximately 45 minutes later it was lunch time. Johnson stated that [redacted] always receives an Ensure with his lunch meal. Johnson stated that one of the other kids took [redacted] Ensure and he became irate about it. Johnson stated that [redacted] became furious and wanted to fight, so Johnson took the Ensure and placed it in his pocket. Johnson stated that he attempted to calm [redacted] down, but was unsuccessful. Johnson stated that [redacted] pushed him in the chest area. Johnson stated that he immediately grabbed [redacted] and called for assistance. Johnson stated that in order to gain control he placed [redacted] on the ground. Johnson stated that [redacted] continued to struggle and resist. Johnson stated that [redacted] got his left arm loose and was able to strike him in the left side of his facial area. Johnson stated that shortly after, staff was able to gain control of [redacted] and he calmed down. Johnson stated that [redacted] went to his room without incident. Johnson stated that [redacted] had not taken his medications which was the cause for the violent outburst.

Deputy Walker asked Johnson if he needed medical assistance, but he declined.

Deputy Walker made contact with [redacted] stated that he felt challenged when Johnson took his Ensure so he began to act out.

Deputy Walker made contact with Robert Bonnett, with the Pulaski County Juvenile Intake. Deputy

Walker advised Bonnett of the incident that took place. Bonnett advised Deputy Walker to cite for Battery 2nd Degree and issue a court date of 6/15/2022.
