## Primary Narrative By Myron Bell, 08/08/22 23:04

### Battery 2nd

On August 8, 2022 around 2017 hours Deputies responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Youth Home for a disturbance. Upon Deputy Bell's arrival, contact was made with staff members Tara Brown and Lamont Ramirez. Ms. Brown stated before she arrived at the youth home, [redacted] ran away from the facility and hit someone's motorcycle with a stick, no damage was sustained to the motorcycle. Owner of the motorcycle was unknown. Ms. Brown stated when she arrived at the youth home the children stated she was a snitch because she advised other staff member what [redacted] had done. Ms. Brown stated three of the juveniles: [redacted] began trying to fight staff. In the mist of fighting staff Ms. Brown stated [redacted] pointed a toy gun at her simulating shooting her and stated he would kill staff. [redacted] bit staff member Lamont Ramirez on the arm ( no pictures of the injury was taken nor did MEMS response to the scene) and stated he would shoot Ms. Brown in the head, and [redacted] also threatened to kill staff members. While on scene Deputy Bell ask Deputy Burke to watch juvenile [redacted] while he contacted the juvenile intake officer. While watching [redacted] Deputy Burke stated [redacted] attempted to grab his firearm out of his holster and later kicked Deputy Burke in the legs. Deputy Bell informed Intake Officer Carder of the incident that had taken place and she advised that he would be accepted in the juvenile detention facility. [redacted] was transported to the Pulaski County Juvenile Facility.
