## Primary Narrative By Dylan Burke, 08/08/22 23:01

### Battery

On 8/8/2022 (Monday), at approximately 2218 hours, I was dispatched to take a report via telephone in reference to two incidents occurring on separate dates involving battery.

I made phone contact with Leah Parkhurst, she advised that [redacted] was involved in two incidents at 20400 Colonel Glenn (Youth Home) in reference to a battery.

The first incident took place on 7/11/2022, Leah advised that [redacted] attacked a child unprovoked and the child suffered only minor injuries. Leah stated she could not provide further details on the incident due to the Youth Home not providing her with details due to Hipa Laws.

The second incident took place on 8/1/2022, Leah advised that [redacted] attacked a staff member, destroyed a room, and made homicidal threats toward staff with a shank. Leah was provided with limited details on the incident by the Youth Home.
