## Primary Narrative By Wade Sawyer, 09/06/22 16:15

### Battery in the Second Degree

On 09/06/2022 at approximately 1615 hours, I received a call for service regarding a battery that already occurred at 20400 Colonel Glenn RD, Little Rock, AR 72210.

I made contact with Marcus Daily. Marcus is a teacher at the Youth Home located at the aforementioned address. Marcus stated that he was in the process of breaking up two Juveniles in a physical altercation when he was grabbed from behind by the Juvenile in question. Marcus stated that the Juvenile grabbed him from behind, choking him, and threw him off of the other two Juveniles.

During this time, the Juvenile began resisting the Youth Home workers. Marcus stated that during the physical altercation of restraining the Juvenile; he bit two staff members, struck another, and head-butted another staff member. The staff member that were struck were not present at the time of the investigation. Marcus stated that he wanted to press charges. Marcus sustained a minor abrasion to his right knee during the altercation, but refused medical. Marcus stated that there is video evidence of the physical altercation and will provide it when able.

I charged the Juvenile with (5-13-202) Battery in the second degree. I called the Juvenile intake officer, Martha Carter, who instructed me to cite the Juvenile and provide him with a court date. I filled out an Arrest Disposition form and informed the Juvenile's Father.

I spoke with the Juvenile and informed him that he was being charged with Battery in the second degree. I informed the Juvenile of the court processes. I informed the Juvenile that his father was notified. The Juvenile was polite and respectful to deputies. I asked the Juvenile what his side of the story was. The Juvenile stated that his friend was in a verbal/physical altercation that Marcus tried to separate. The Juvenile stated that all he did was pull Marcus off of his friend. The Juvenile stated that while in a physical altercation with the other staff members, he was struck in the face. The Juvenile declined medical assistance.

I took pictures of all injures, completed an Arrest Disposition form, and provided all parties with the report number. I provided a copy of the Arrest Disposition form to the Youth Home. When I receive the video evidence I will update it with the report.
