Terroristic threatening 2nd

On September 09, 2022 Deputy Bell responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn for a disturbance. Upon Deputy Bell's arrival contact was made with staff member Sean Thompson and resident [REDACTED]. Mr. Thompson stated there was an incident involving [REDACTED] where he became aggressive toward staff members and threw things/items inside of the group home. Mr. Thompson stated it had been reported [REDACTED] had hit one of his peers and other staff members removed that peer from the residence until things cooled down. Next, [REDACTED] stated they were playing basketball how they normally play and he had his forearm up, and [REDACTED] stated to [REDACTED] that he was touching him. [REDACTED] stated he said to [REDACTED] he was sorry if he was touching him and backed up. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] attempted to hit him with his elbow, so he backed up and went inside the group home and told staff he need somewhere quiet where he could calm down.

[REDACTED] stated his asked staff if he could sit in the van and they said no, he could go in one of the rooms in the front. [REDACTED] stated he couldn't concentrate because there was still alot of noise due to there being some people up front. [REDACTED] stated he went outside and sat on top of the van and Ms. Kirkwood asked him to get off at least 3 to 4 times. [REDACTED] stated he was in the process of getting off the van the third time he was asked, but [REDACTED] repeatedly approached the van making a motion as if he was going to throw the basketball so he stayed in the van. [REDACTED] stated Ms. Kirkwood ask him to get off the van but he could not get off at that time so he just sat there.

[REDACTED] stated he asked Mr. Thompson if [REDACTED] and he could be separated and he came in the residence. Next Deputy Bell made contact with Natasha Kirkwood who stated when she called the Sheriff's Office, [REDACTED] was very unstable and threatening to whoop staff who had to put him in restraints by saying (I'm beat y'all ass when y'all let me up). Ms. Kirkwood also stated [REDACTED] broke furniture and attempted to leave the residence which was the reason they put him in a restraint. Ms. Kirkwood stated she call the Sheriff's Office because for over 20 minutes [REDACTED] would not comply with staff and was irate. Ms. Kirkwood stated staff made [REDACTED] clean-up most of the items he damaged or threw down, but he broke the legs of the chairs in a room in the front of the group home. Deputy Bell asked Ms. Kirkwood if she knew how the incident started. Ms. Kirkwood stated [REDACTED] said one of his peers and he was playing and he touched him, but he didn't not notify staff of the situation.

Deputy Bell made contact with [REDACTED] who stated they were playing football and he accidentally ripped shirt and he apologized for it; [REDACTED] stated it was ok. [REDACTED] stated afterward they went inside the youth home and came

back outside when Mr. Thompson arrived for his shift. ■■■ stated Mr. Thompson went to pick up some kids and came back. ■■■ stated ■■■ was talking with some of the kids. ■■■ stated one of the peers felt threatened by the other one and Mr. Thompson talked to both kids. ■■■ stated he and ■■■ were outside while everyone else was inside the home and ■■■ stated to him "what's up" as if he wanted to fight. ■■■ stated he thought ■■■ was just playing at first because they play like that sometimes but he soon realized he was serious. ■■■ stated ■■■ started swinging at him and he began to back up. ■■■ stated continued throwing punches striking him the in shoulder a couple of times. ■■■ stated he put his foot out towards ■■■ to stop him, and that's when Mr. Thompson came outside and stated for them to stop. Lastly Deputy Bell made contact with staff member Stacy Prime who stated she witnessed ■■■ hit ■■■ when they were on the basketball court when she was pulling up.

Ms. Prime stated she hurried up and parked and as she was walking to the front door, Mr. Thompson was at the front door telling ■■■ to come inside. Ms. Prime stated ■■■ and ■■■ begin to square up at each other as if they were about to fight before ■■■ went in the house. Ms. Prime stated ■■■ was acting up stating no one (staff) was going to take his electronics away from him. Ms. Prime stated the caveat was for ■■■ to calm down so he could get his electronics back, but when staff advised him he couldn't get his electronics back he just became irate. Ms. Prime stated she took the other kids for a walk outside while other staff was dealing with ■■■ but she do know he attempted to run out the side door.
