

stated his asked staff if he could sit in the van and they said no, he could go in one of the rooms in the front. stated he couldn't concentrate because there was still alot of noise due to there being some people up front. stated he went outside and sat on top of the van and Ms. Kirkwood asked him to get off at least 3 to 4 times. stated he was in the process of getting off the van the third time he was asked, but repeatedly approached the van making a motion as if he was going to throw the basketball so he stayed in the van. Kirkwood ask him to get off the van but he could not get off at that time so he just sat there.

stated he asked Mr. Thompson if and he could be separated and he came in the residence. Next Deputy Bell made contact with Natasha Kirkwood who stated when she called the Sheriff's Office, was very unstable and threatening to whoop staff who had to put him in restraints by saying (I'm beat y'all ass when y'all let me up). Ms. Kirkwood also stated broke furniture and attempted to leave the residence which was the reason they put him in a restraint. Ms. Kirkwood stated she call the Sheriff's Office because for over 20 minutes would not comply with staff and was irate. Ms. Kirkwood stated staff made clean-up most of the items he damaged or threw down, but he broke the legs of the chairs in a room in the front of the group home. Deputy Bell asked Ms. Kirkwood if she knew how the incident started. Ms. Kirkwood stated said one of his peers and he was playing and he touched him, but he didn't not notify staff of the situation.

Deputy Bell made contact with who stated they were playing football and he accidentally ripped shirt and he apologized for it; \_\_\_\_\_ stated it was ok. Stated afterward they went inside the youth home and came
