## Primary Narrative By Steven Bass, 10/04/22 23:58

### Suicide Attempt

On 10-4-2022 at 1856 hours I, Deputy Bass, was dispatched to the Youth Home at 20400 Col Glenn Rd in reference to a suicide attempt by one of the female juvenile patients there.

Upon arrival, MEMS and Rescue were already on scene. The juvenile, [REDACTED], was already loaded on MEMS truck 436, and MEMS was actively working to get [REDACTED] ready for transport. I observed that [REDACTED] was alert and breathing, and responding to MEMS questions. I observed that [REDACTED] had a bright red mark encircling her neck.

I then made contact with Chastity Robinson, staff at Youth Home, who had found [REDACTED]. Robinson stated that [REDACTED] had a bad experience in therapy today, and was very emotional. Robinson stated that [REDACTED] later calmed down, and asked Robinson if she could take her shower for the evening. Robinson explained that the patients are given 10 minutes to shower, and that they set timers for the patients. Robinson stated that she told [REDACTED] she could take her shower, and set a timer for [REDACTED]. Robinson stated that when the timer went off, she went to get [REDACTED] from the shower. Robinson stated that she knocked, but did not get an answer. Robinson stated that she knocked again, and advised [REDACTED] that she was coming into the bathroom.

Robinson stated that she opened the door and found [REDACTED] laying on the floor, red and purple in the face. Robinson stated that she yelled for help and removed a white string and towel from around [REDACTED] neck. Robinson suspected that [REDACTED] tried to hang herself from the shower rod.

[REDACTED] was transported to Children's Hospital by MEMS for evaluation. Youth Home staff advised that [REDACTED] would not be returning to their facility, and would be admitted to another facility.
