In return [redacted] climbed onto an awning on the sidewalk between to buildings. [redacted] then jumped on the other side of the fence and off the property. No injuries reported.

Report Description: On 8-13-22 [REDACTED] (DOB) was outside with his unit and then when the unit was scheduled to go back inside he refused to go inside. Staff member attempted to process with resident and he decided to climb onto the awning on the sidewalk between the two buildings. He acted like he was going to come down from the awning but decided to jump on the other side of the fence and off the property. Staff member was able to follow resident off property while he was gone. This occurred at approximately 1705 and the Fayetteville Police Department was notified at 1712. About an hour later [REDACTED] returned to the facility with staff and the FPD confirmed that the resident was back on grounds. He did not appear to have any injuries from the elopement. He was placed on Restricted to Unit to be re-evaluated in hours, placed on elopement precautions and will follow up with his Primary Therapist.
