The peer became upset and stormed off. The Pt felt as though their peer was upset with them and went to her room. When staff tried speaking with the pt, Pt revealed that she had a bandana tied around her neck in attempt to choke herself. The staff gave the Pt the chance to take it off but the Pt refused. The Pt was then placed in a personal restraint. 7:15pm Personal Restraint: The Pt was placed in a personal restraint at this time. The Pt was kicking and fighting against the staff and was attempting to prevent the staff from getting the bandana from around her neck. 7:18pm Personal Restraint End: Personal restraint ended at this time. The Pt was able to contract for safety and was able to show she was calm and the restraint could end. 7:19pm Personal Restraint: The Pt was placed in a personal restraint at this time due to becoming aggressive again towards staff. The Pt fought against the staff in attempt to be released. 7:21pm Personal Restraint End: The Pt was released for their restraint after being able to contract for safety as well as being able to be physically calm. Patient Debriefing date/time: 09/20/22 8:30pm Time was spent validating the patients feelings. Pt stated that she understood why staff had to intervene. Staff discussed with the Pt better ways to handle moments like this in the future and to remember her coping skills in times of high stress. Nursing Assessment date/time: 09/20/22 Sitting in her closet in her room processing with staff and her "best friend". Alert and oriented to person, place and time. PERRLA. Calm and cooperative at this time. No bruising or swelling noted to neck. Respirations 14 and non-labored. Pulse 70. Denies pain or difficulty breathing. Full range of

motion in neck. Gait steady and WNL. States that she became upset over making her friend upset. Denies continued desire to self harm. Discusses ways to process feelings in the future rather than resorting to suicidal gestures. Agrees to remain safe at this time. Placed on eyeball. Will continue to monitor. Guardian was notified on 09/20/22 at 9:40pm
