weekend with her family and return the morning of 10/10/2022, later same date vape was  
found on the unit and was found to be concealed in [REDACTED] hygiene. [REDACTED] stated that the vape  
contained THC was stolen from her mother's purse. Resident was exhibiting common  
behaviors that are associated with being under the influence of marijuana including  
cloudy/reddened eyes and behaviors outside resident's baselines. [REDACTED] is being closely  
monitored by nursing staff under the direction of our doctor, and if any decline in symptoms  
are noted, the resident will be taken to the nearest hospital for further evaluation. We will be  
making necessary corrections in procedure as far as hygiene inspections as we go forward.

Interim Action Narrative: The police were called. Resident was on misconduct precaution  
safety plan for 7 days. [REDACTED].  
She will continue to be monitored by nursing.

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**Licensing Narrative: Facility reported that a resident brought THC via vape pen into the facility when returning from a pass/visit with family. Licensing Specialist was informed that body safety checks, residents belongings, and personal hygiene items are checked. However, the resident hid the vape pen in the middle of her deodorant. The nurse had to remove all the deodorant, it was not visible. Licensing Specialist was provided with the following policy documentation: Therapeutic Passes and Body Safety Checklist. No licensing concerns noted.**
