Report Description: I wanted to notify you of an incident that occurred at The Centers (EMAC) on 11/05/2022. On 11/05/2022, at approximately 1344 hours, client was inside a bathroom in the dorm area when she refused to DOB: verbally respond to staff. Due to the fact would not verbally respond, staff entered the bathroom and found her () wrapping a piece of clothing around her neck. did not have the clothing affixed to any object. Staff was able to remove the clothing neck, causing her to become aggressive towards staff. In an effort from around safe, she was placed in an Emergency Safety Intervention (ESI). The ESI to keep lasted approximately 8 minutes. After was released from the ESI, Centers medical personnel assessed her. Medical personnel noted was not in acute distress, had no complaints of pain and her vitals were stable. Medical personnel did not note any marks (neck) or injuries to due to this incident. On 11/07/2022, Centers Medical Director, Dr. Bowling, spoke with told Dr. Bowling that she wanted to die on Saturday (11/05) and she is sad that staff intervened. After speaking with and reviewing the facts connected to this event, Dr. Bowling determined this incident should be classified as an Attempted Suicide. ?s guardian was notified about this incident. is a private placement client at The Centers.
