Licensing Specialist completed a buildings and grounds walkthrough of the South, West, North, East (units), Multipurpose Room, Day Room, Gym, Phone Room, Cafeteria, Staff Breakroom, Computer Room, outdoors,

and Classrooms. The cafeteria had just been cleaned. Licensing Specialist smelled the cleaner and observed the floor was wet from being mopped. The phone room was cleaned and free of debris. This room was set up like closet size cubicles (no doors open space) for four (4) residents to use the cordless phone. The staff breakroom was clean. There was one staff member utilizing the staff breakroom when Licensing Specialist walked through.

Licensing Specialist observed residents participating in recreational therapy while in the gym. Some residents appeared to be shooting hoops, some sitting against a wall talking to a staff member, and others were standing around communicating with each other, ratio 3:13. The rest of this age group were outside for their recreational therapy, ratio 2:6. Licensing Specialist observed the girl's restroom by the gym. The bathroom was clean and free of debris. The boy's bathroom was occupied, Licensing Specialist was unable to observe this bathroom.

School is still in session. 12/16/2022 will be the last day for residents to attend for 2022. Classes will resume in January 2023. Classroom 4 were in the computer lab. Licensing Specialist observed the computer lab (Engineering Class), ratio 4:14. Classroom 5, ratio 3:13. Classroom 3, ratio 3:16. Classroom 2, were in the activity room, ratio 2:7.

Licensing Specialist observed the Christmas decorations on each unit. All decorations were made from paper. The residents were very creative with their artwork. East Unit (girls' unit) the ratio was 3:14. Licensing Specialist observed the girls in the dayroom area and in the hallway either sitting down watching television or standing up talking with peers or staff. Residents on the North Unit were not on the unit when Licensing Specialist arrived. Licensing Specialist observed bedrooms: 201, 202, 203, 204, 206, and 207. Bedrooms on this unit were organized, there was no debris on the floor or beds. West Unit, ratio 1:1. Resident informed Licensing Specialist that the West Unit was the best unit. Licensing Specialist observed bedrooms 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, and 106. West Unit was more organized than the other units. South Unit was clean and free of debris. Licensing Specialist observed bedrooms: 400, 401, 402, 403, 404, 405, 406, 407, 408, and 409. All bedrooms organized on the South Unit. Licensing Specialist did not observe much Christmas decoration on this unit. Licensing Specialist was informed that some residents got upset and destroyed the Christmas decorations. Licensing Specialist observed the dayroom and supply room, both rooms were cleaned and free of debris.
