**Incident Description:** Licensing received a phone call on the afternoon of 2/25/22 stating that a "little" had complained of another "little" touching him in the "penile" area. Report sent by facility regarding this incident reads: On 02.25.22, Risk spoke with client [REDACTED] regarding inappropriate touching on the unit. [REDACTED] stated when he and his peers play Hide and Seek, one of his peers touch the genital area on top of his clothing. [REDACTED] stated that he told the peer to stop, and the peer stopped and laughed. [REDACTED] says that the peer touches his genital area only when playing Hide and Seek. When asked has anything other than inappropriate touch has been displayed on the unit. Resident [REDACTED] replied no.

**Agency's Interim Corrective Action:** Risk has reminded staff that no horse playing is allowed on the units. We remind staff to monitor the resident's interaction closely and keep all doors locked when not accompanied by a resident. [REDACTED] and his peers have been reminded to hold hands and fe
