BODY CAM ACTIVE

On February 28th 2022 around 20:17 I was dispatched to 2466 S 48th street to the Woodridge Behavioral Care. Dispatch advised there was physical fight in progress.

Upon arrival I made contact with the on duty staff in the room of the fight. The staff member was identified as Tamaira Huggins (B/F DOB: 07/23/1996). Tamaira advised [REDACTED] had been attacked by [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Tamaira informed me [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had all been antagonizing [REDACTED] all night and had been making threats. Tamaira advised me when all the girls were in the same room [REDACTED] walked towards [REDACTED] and started the physical fight. Shortly after [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] began to fight [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] joined in to attack [REDACTED]

Two other juveniles inside the room when the fight happened confirmed that Tamaira's story was true. [REDACTED] was currently getting medical attention from the fire department. Officer Castanada #383 later went with [REDACTED] to NWMC.

I attempted to contact all juvenile's parents but only got a hold of [REDACTED] who was informed the situation. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were all given court dates for Battery 3rd with separate court dates assigned by the juvenile detention on duty staff. I issued and explained [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] their citations. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] signed stating they understood their court dates. The written statment of [REDACTED] and a 'Face Sheet' from the facility was uploaded to the server. There are active in service cameras that were viewed by a different officer. The video footage could not be obtained from the on duty staff.

Description:

BWC ACTIVATED

On February 27, 2022 at approximately 2007 hours, I responded to 2466 S. 48th St. (Woodridge Behavioral Care LLC.) for a disturbance. The caller stated there was a physical fight in progress between the residents. There were approximately five girls involved. The staff on scene advised there weren't enough of them on scene to break up the fight.

Upon arrival, contact was made with a staff member at the front entrance. She advised the girls were still physically fighting. Officer Stone #357 and I walked back to the unit with the staff member. Upon arriving to the unit the girls were no longer fighting. I observed a female sitting on a chair visibly upset stating she had just been jumped. She was later identified as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated her head hurt as well as her ribs. The Springdale Fire Department was requested on scene. Once they arrived on scene they transported [REDACTED] to The Children's hospital for further medical attention.

I followed the squad to Children's hospital. At Children's Hospital [REDACTED] stated she was having issues with three other girls in her unit by the names of [REDACTED]. She stated they were verbally trying to get her to react to start a physical altercation. At one point she stated the girls jumped her. They hit her head and her ribs. [REDACTED] also stated during the altercation someone bit her left hand.

Officer Stone informed me he made contact with [REDACTED] mother and informed her of the situation. [REDACTED] also provided a written statement and I was able to obtain a copy of [REDACTED] face sheet (information) from the facility.

All contact was ended shortly after.
