Description:

On Friday March 25, 2022 I was dispatched to a Runaway child call at The Perimeter of the Ozarks.

While en route I was advised that there had been a disturbance at this location where one of the Juveniles had pulled the fire alarm which unlocked the doors allowing multiple of the juveniles to escape the facility.

Upon arrival I observed that all of the doors were unlocked and made my way to the main holding area where I made contact with one of the workers. Upon entering the holding area I immediately observed that there were multiple juveniles yelling and workers running around attempting to restore order. I asked the worker what happened and information on any of the juveniles that managed to escape. The workers were eventually able to get the remaining children back into their rooms and able to get a head count to provide me with an accurate count of 3 juveniles that had managed to run away.

I then began gathering the needed information for my report when I was informed by another juvenile [REDACTED] that lives in the facility that she had been threatened by [REDACTED], one of the 3 runaways, who told her that they were going to get out.

[REDACTED] advised that when she told [REDACTED] that she did not want to go that [REDACTED] threatened her and said "if you don't help I'm going to kill you". [REDACTED] advised that she then barricaded the door out of fear of [REDACTED]

The Juveniles then pulled the fire alarm to unlock the doors and ran from the scene before fire and police could arrive on scene.

Looking at [REDACTED] I observed that she appeared to be covered with some kind of black substance and when I asked about it I was advised that they

water in the sprinkler system was died in order to identify anyone who activates the system without cause.

While I was filling out the runaway forms I was notified by Springdale Dispatch that one of the juveniles had been located at the Casey's General Store nearby and an officer was able to locate and transport her back to the facility. The staff advised that [REDACTED] had been wearing a red hoodie and the other juvenile had been wearing a black shirt and green shorts.

I then finished the needed forms on scene and gathered photos for the juveniles and as I was leaving another call came in for a welfare check for 2 juvenile females matching the description of the runaways.

I proceeded to the area where officers were finally able to locate them walking through the park. When I approached the juveniles I observed that these were the same females from their photos and that [REDACTED] red hoodie had the same black die from the sprinkler system as the victim.

[REDACTED] initially fain ignorance and pretend that she had never heard of The Perimeter of the Ozarks and that she did not know who [REDACTED] was.

I then placed [REDACTED] under arrest for Terroristic Threats 1st and Communicating a False Alarm and transported her to the Springdale Jail.

When I had initially made contact with [REDACTED] she was compliant but when I placed her in the back of my patrol vehicle she became very vocal and yelled and screamed at me making comments that she was going to get out and kill me and flailing around in the back seat kicking the door and cage, attempting to break the window and Plexiglas dividers.

Once back at the Springdale Jail I filled out the booking sheet and then turned her over to the Jailers for processing.

While I was working on the preliminary report to send [REDACTED] to Washington County Juvenile Detention Center I was notified by the Jailers that [REDACTED] was continuing to be belligerent making similar threats to the jailers that when she gets out that she was going to kill them and throwing chairs around the holding cell.

Officers had to assist the jailers in getting [REDACTED] back into handcuffs for transport and when she was placed into the transport van she spit onto one of the jailers. Therefore an additional charge of Aggravated Assault upon a Law Enforcement Officer was added to [REDACTED]
