Description:

State Police Investigator Misty Dunn interviewed [REDACTED] at Perimeter of the Ozarks. Dunn sent me her notes on the interview. I placed a copy of the notes in the case file. The following is a summary of the interview.

[REDACTED] stated that she was in a relationship with [REDACTED] which is also in Perimeter of the Ozarks. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] would pull her up next to [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] would put her hands into [REDACTED] pants and put her fingers in [REDACTED] vagina. [REDACTED] said that this has happened numerous times and that she had never said anything to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that when [REDACTED] did this [REDACTED] would put her hands on [REDACTED] hips. [REDACTED] explained that she tried to push [REDACTED] back one time and had never told [REDACTED] that the touching was not ok or told [REDACTED] to stop. [REDACTED] said that she had reported this incident to staff and they moved [REDACTED] to a different area of the facility.

Dunn found that [REDACTED] was in foster care and as such had an attorney Ad Litem which would not allow Dunn or Law Enforcement to interview [REDACTED].

Dunn told me that State Police was going to close this case unfounded. Based on Dunn's interview and that fact that [REDACTED] had not relayed to [REDACTED] that the touching was unwanted and not ok with [REDACTED] this case will be closed. REN321
