Mr. Givens stated that's when [redacted] walked on him in an aggressive manner and punched him in the shoulder. Deputy Bell ask Mr. Givens was his shoulder injured or did he have any pain and he stated not at the moment. There was not marks or bruising either. Next deputy Bell made contact with [redacted] and ask him did he punch Mr. Bill. [redacted] shook his head yes, Deputy Bell ask why and he stated because Mr. Bill was blaming stuff on him. [redacted] stated he unexpectedly hit Mr. Bill. [redacted] later apologized to Mr. Bill for punching him.
