## Primary Narrative By David Guarno, 11/15/22 19:30

### BATTERYB IN THE THIRD DEGREE

On 11/15/22, at 1701 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (Youth Home) in reference to a battery.

Upon arrival, I made contact with a staff member, Aquarius Walker. A. Walker advised that two of the children in her house had gotten into a physical altercation earlier today on the school bus. She then directed me to speak with the victim, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised that on this date, around 16:30 hours, he was arguing on the school bus with another student, [REDACTED]. He advised that him and [REDACTED] were going back and forth arguing and that it resulted in [REDACTED] punching him in the face, just above his right eye. I looked at [REDACTED] and observed swelling just above his right eye, similar to that of having been struck with a closed fist. [REDACTED] advised that there were no witnesses to the incident and that nobody was watching them when it happened.

I then spoke with [REDACTED] regarding the events earlier. [REDACTED] was advised of his Miranda Rights in the presence of A. Walker and he agreed to speak to me about what happened. [REDACTED] stated that at no point did he ever punch [REDACTED] and he did not know why [REDACTED] would say that this happened. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] has been having issues with multiple kids and that it could be one of them who hit him.

I then resumed speaking with A. Walker about the situation. At this time, [REDACTED] approached this deputy and asked what would happen if he told the truth. [REDACTED] then advised that he did punch [REDACTED] but only because [REDACTED] was in his face and breathing on his neck. [REDACTED] then advised he lied at first because he did not want to get in trouble.

A. Walker advised that there is surveillance footage on the school bus that she could request in the future if need be. A. Walker also advised that she would be speaking with [REDACTED] therapist to see if alternative housing arrangements can be made at the facility to keep him away from [REDACTED]

A. Walker was given the report number in regards to this incident and instructed to contact PCSO if she needs additional assistance.

It should be noted that due to staff quickly taking [REDACTED] to a medical facility to get his eye examined, I was unable to get a photograph of his injury.
