Description:

On Wednesday, 11/16/2022 at approximately 1942 hours I responded to 2466 S 48th St B (Perimeter of the Ozarks) for a Disturbance Call. Dispatch received a 911 Hangup from a landline at the location. Upon call back they could hear a male and female yelling at each other.

Upon my arrival, I was escorted through the building by an employee with Officer Mesinar (347). Once we made it to the Behavioral health units, I observed a large B/F banging loudly on one of the locked doors while she was yelling at people on the other side of the door. Once we made contact with her, she attempted to walk past Officer Mesinar and myself. Officer Mesinar detained her in handcuffs as she was not compliant and said she was going to "kill all the hoes" including us. She was later identified as [REDACTED]. As Officer Mesinar remained with [REDACTED], I made contact with the other party involved in the disturbance. She identified herself as Jakya Williams (B/F DOB: 09/10/1998). Jakya is an employee at Perimeter of the Ozarks.

Jakya stated that she had been having problems with [REDACTED] all day as [REDACTED] misconstrued something that she said earlier while the girls were allowed to put makeup on themselves. Jakya said that she said someone had left out wipes with makeup on them and she made a comment about it being nasty and [REDACTED] took it as Jakya calling her nasty. Jakya stated around 1900 hours, she was following an employee to another unit from [REDACTED] unit and [REDACTED] forced herself out of the door. She said that some words were exchanged between her and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] grabbed a big binder and threw it at her making contact with her right arm. She also said that when [REDACTED] was close enough to her she said she was going to "beat her ass" and also spit on her arm. Jakya said that she separated herself from [REDACTED] and then Police arrived. She said she wanted to press charges against [REDACTED].

I made contact with Washington County Juvenile intake and reported the incident. They gave me the court date of 12/30/2022 at 1330 hours for Division 3 Juvenile Court at 885 Clydesdale Dr in Fayetteville. I completed a citation for Assault 2nd and explained it to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] signed the citation and I provided a copy to an employee who said they would give it to their manager. Jakya provided a written statement for the incident. No injuries were reported at the time.

My BWC was activated. BDB 363

Description:

On 11/16/2022 at 1942 hours I responded to Perimeter of the Ozarks (2466 S 48th St B) for a Disturbance, which started as a 911 hangup.. Dispatch stated they could here a male and female yelling in the background but no one was directly on the line.

Upon my arrival I walked toward the middle of the building with Officer Barnett #363 and located [REDACTED] yelling and pounding on one of the doors to the sleeping quarters. I tried to get her attention but she continued banging on the door and cursing loudly as she did so. I was finally able to get her to turn around but she started walking away. I grabbed her left arm above her elbow and told her not to walk away from me. She yelled and cursed at me telling me not to touch her. I let go thinking she would be calm but she began walking away again. I held onto her arm again and she began pulling away, yelling and screaming as she did so. I faced her toward the wall and chose to detain her in handcuffs due to her demeanor. I was able to successfully get one cuff on her left wrist but she would not comply when I told her to give me her right hand. Officer Barnett had to assist and pull her arm from the front of her body and bring it to the back so I could detain her. Once we did without incident I brought her away from the door so I could speak to her. As I was walking her away she yelled at me multiple times to take the handcuffs off or else she would spit on me and Officer Barnett.

Again, she was cursing and yelling profanities so it took a few minutes for me to figure out what she was wanting from us. She told me she called the police and wanted to complain about one of the employees of the center for assaulting her. She was yelling at me the entire time and not answering my questions. When I attempted to get her name from her replied with, "Suck a dick.com." I asked her two more times, but received the same answer both times. I then told her I was there to help her and she slightly deescalated where I could get her name. She eventually told me one of the employees (Jakya Williams B/F dob: 09/10/1998) was insulting her earlier in the day and it made her angry. They began arguing and Ms. Williams then threw a chair at her. [REDACTED] said she was scared for her safety when this happened, thinking she would get hurt. She gave me no details but instead continued yelling and cursing saying we would have to come back because she wanted to go to jail.

Soon after it was discovered [REDACTED] was the aggressor earlier in the day and Officer Barnett issued her a citation. See his narrative for further.

[REDACTED] was released back to the care of the employees after she was given her citation.
