## Narrative - Hubanks, Chad - 12/2/2022 6:10:00 PM (Initial)

On December 02, 2022 at approximately 1810 hours, I spoke with Darlene Stone on the phone regarding her son, [REDACTED] being assaulted by another juvenile patient while at Mill Creek of Arkansas and is having emergency surgery at this time. Mrs. Stone stated that the incident occurred on November 26, 2022 at approximately 0922 hours. Mrs. Stone advised me that she lives in Las Vegas, Nevada and was on her way to Arkansas. At approximately 1825 hours, I spoke with Nurse Lilly Harris and she stated that she knew the incident happened, but did not know the details but stated that law enforcement was not notified because the incident involved two juveniles.

On December 06, 2022 [REDACTED] went to Mill Creek of Arkansas and spoke with Chris Butler regarding the incident. Mr. Butler stated that [REDACTED] was sitting in a chair and when walked by to leave, another juvenile had taken a bottle from his back pocket. Several juveniles were playing keep the bottle away from Mr. Butler when the bottle hit the floor. [REDACTED] got up and picked up the bottle and handed back to Mr. Butler. [REDACTED] got mad at [REDACTED] and told him that he was going to fight him. [REDACTED] stated that he was not fighting and Mr.

[REDACTED] hit [REDACTED] in his right eye three times. [REDACTED] was transported to Children's hospital where they found out that [REDACTED] had three fractures to his right eye socket and sent him into emergency surgery.

On December 12, 2022 at approximately 1642 hours, I spoke with Juvenile Officer Becky Cathy and advised her of the incident that took place at Mill Creek of Arkansas between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Mrs. Cathy stated that she would speak with the Judge on December 13, 2022 to find out if they can proceed with the charges.
