Battery

On 12/14/2022 at approximately 1004 hours, Deputy Scott and I arrived at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road Youth Home for a Battery.

Upon arrival, I was met by the Program Director, Rita Williams, who called about the incident. Williams took us to speak with Marcus Daily, the victim, and teacher. Daily had an apparent wound to his left ear. He told us that [redacted] hit him this morning. Daily stated that [redacted] was yelling and threatening another student.

Daily said he intervened and that [redacted] left with other staff members. Daily also stated that when [redacted] returned, he was still upset and started yelling at him when he spoke to him. [redacted] then threw the book at Daily and missed. [redacted] then swung and hit Daily with his fist in the left ear, leaving it bleeding, and his jaw was sore and swollen.

Deputy Scott took photo evidence of the injuries. In addition, two witnesses saw the incident happen. Taylor Tull and Stephen Wells gave witness statements to the incident.

Deputy Scott and I contacted the Juvenile Intake Deputy and were given a court date of 02/15/2023 at 0930 hours. I gave Daily and Williams a contact card with the report number. All evidence was logged into the property room.
