## Primary Narrative By Myron Bell, 12/21/22 23:11

### Disturbance

On December 21, 2022 around 1854 hours Deputy Bell responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn in reference to a disturbance. Upon Deputy Bell's arrival contact was made with Staff members Lamont Ramirez and Sean Thompson. Deputy Bell ask what was the issue, Mr. Ramirez stated the usual wrestling, fighting, kicking and bite hit on the arm. Mr. Ramirez stated [REDACTED] had been acting out all day. Mr. Ramirez stated [REDACTED] was teasing and using racial slur against another client ([REDACTED]) by calling him a monkey, but [REDACTED] didn't respond back. Mr. Ramirez stated [REDACTED] was "frozen" and he wasn't allowed out of his room, but he was out of his room being disruptive while staff was trying to get different tasks taken care of.

Mr. Ramirez stated [REDACTED] friend [REDACTED] who is also "frozen" and is not allowed out of his room either, however they allowed them to take for about 30 minutes just to let them know we not tripping , but now it's time to go to your room. Mr. Ramirez stated [REDACTED] didn't want to go to his room. Mr. Ramirez stated they were a no touch facility and [REDACTED] walks over and started kicking on [REDACTED] Mr. Ramirez stated at that point is when he guided [REDACTED] to his room. Mr. Ramirez stated [REDACTED] stopped and stated no I'm not going and that's when the physical altercation happened. Mr. Ramirez stated he did not want to press any charges at this time.

Deputy Bell spoke with [REDACTED] who stated he was upset because he was just chilling and the next thing he know he was being told he can't do nothing. [REDACTED] stated staff is always talking about doing stuff to keep them calm, but when they do it they're being told they can't do it. [REDACTED] stated Mr. Lamont motion him to go back to his room and was guiding him alone the way. [REDACTED] stated he stopped to remove Mr. Lamont arm off of him and he was going to walk to his room. [REDACTED] stated Mr. Lamont grabbed him and that is when he begin to fighting back. Deputy Bell stated to [REDACTED] he had to followed the rules set forth by staff and if he had an issues he need to advised staff.
