Narrative

On 01/08/2023 at 1935 hours I, Deputy J. Gardner responded to 161 Skunk Hollow Road in reference to an alleged sexual assault of a juvenile (Victim). This information was received via telephone from the second second sexual assault of a juvenile victim's brother due to a language barrier with the juvenile's mother, **Second Second** (Other Person). Mrs. Stated that while on the phone with her daughter she was told about a sexual incident that had occurred with an unnamed male staff member (Offender).

Upon arrival at the facility I attempted contact with employees at the front entrance, however it was approximately 10 minutes before anyone came to the front reception area. I made contact with Quindariean Coleman (Other Person), an employee, who stated he had been told about the incident and knew the incident was being looked into by the directors and other staff members of the facility. Mr. Coleman stated the juvenile had not been clear on the details of the incident and that it had been looked into previously as well.

I then made contact with Nedra Jones (Other Person), Director of Nursing, via telephone. Ms. Jones advised the staff had been informed of the incident on this date at approximately 1800 hours and had made all parties of the facility aware of the information. I advised Ms. Jones that an accusation needed to be reported as soon as safely possible to do so, to which she responded they were going to contact the Child Abuse Hotline in the morning. I advised Ms. Jones that the local law enforcement agency needed to be made aware of the accusation as well due to a possible criminal act having been committed. Ms. Jones said they had 24 hours in which to report the incident. I advised her that was incorrect information. Ms. Jones stated she and Jaylen Perkins, another employee, were going to be handling the situation. I made contact with Sergeant C. Pruett of the Faulkner County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division and advised him of the situation. After gathering all information at the time Sergeant Pruett requested a written statement from the juvenile and the initial staff member who took the allegation information.

At that time Corporal Horton, members of Pafford Emergency Medical Services, and I requested to speak with the juvenile. The juvenile was brought to a meeting area where Pafford medics were able to speak with and evaluate the juvenile. While speaking with the juvenile it was determined the incident had occurred previously and she did not feel unsafe due not seeing the staff member recently and being unsure if he still currently is employed there. The juvenile stated that she considered not telling anyone so she could "just forget about it". The juvenile stated that after thinking about it recently she felt that it was wrong and needed to tell someone. The juvenile stated that she had not felt safe to talk about it and that she was unsure if she wanted to hold the person accountable for their actions.

The juvenile then gave a verbal statement of the encounter. The juvenile stated she had gone to the bathroom after her night time medications. The juvenile stated that upon exiting the bathroom she saw the male standing in the area, like he was waiting on her. The juvenile stated she and the male had a brief conversation and stated "I kinda came onto him". The juvenile stated that she then kissed him and he pushed her back against a counter in the area. The juvenile stated she lifted herself onto the counter and pulled down her pants. The juvenile stated the male then "fingered" her until she stated she was uncomfortable. The juvenile stated the male stopped and she pulled her pants back up. The juvenile stated the male then said "we still have time". The juvenile stated that she then left the area. The juvenile stated there was no further interactions with the male other than the male asking days later "Are we good?" to which she responded "Yeah, we good". The juvenile stated there had been no threats or been told not to talk about the incident. The juvenile stated the incident occurred before Christmas but is unsure of what day due to being "locked up" in the facility. The juvenile stated she did not know the male's name. The juvenile described the male as a black male in his 20s, height of 71 or 72 inches, a goatee, always wearing Bass Pro hats, and a jacket. The juvenile stated that for multiple days after the incident she would ask herself "Did it really happen?". The juvenile provided a written statement to that effect.

I spoke with Terrika Harris-Speed (Other Person) of Little Creek Behavioral Health Center, who stated at approximately 1715 hours on this date the juvenile asked to speak with her in private. Harris-Speed stated the

juvenile was unsure of how to tell her about the situation. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile then told her something sexual happened to her and that it was a staff member. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile refused to tell her which staff member it was. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile told her that she waited so long to tell so that the camera system would not have the recordings anymore. Harris-Speed stated she asked the juvenile again about what happened and the juvenile refused to talk about it and stated she was ready to go home. Harris-Speed said that she went and got a witness statement for the juvenile and then came back to speak with her. Harris-Speed stated she and Nurse Kierra were there talking with the juvenile explaining she would not get into trouble. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile told her she had woken up to use the bathroom and asked staff to open the door and upon coming out the male was standing in front of the door. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile then began asking her if she knew why she was in the facility. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile began telling her that she was promiscuous and liked messing with older men. Harris-Speed said the juvenile then resumed the story of the alleged assault by saying she went up to the male and kissed him and then pulled down her pants. Harris-Speed said she then asked the juvenile if there had been any penetration to which the juvenile responded, "only with his finger". Harris-Speed stated the juvenile that it was consensual, and she allowed him to do it. Harris-Speed stated she told the juvenile that she was unable to give consent and it was not her fault this had happened. Harris-Speed stated she asked again, and the juvenile just stated she knows who it was. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile told her the incident occurred during Christmas break or just before. Harris-Speed stated that she then gave the juvenile a break and upon returning asked about when the incident occurred and was told that it happened in November but was unsure of the date. Harris-Speed stated that is when the juvenile began requesting a phone call with her mother. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile began telling her it was because of that incident her program went "down the drain" and that it triggered her due to an incident that occurred when she was 4 years old but waited approximately 10 years to tell anyone about what had occurred. Harris-Speed stated the juvenile then began telling her the whole situation was a blur and she did not remember who it was. Harris-Speed said that during the phone call she told her mother that someone had blocked the door, picked her up, put her on the counter, and fingered her. Harris-Speed stated that at that moment everyone began yelling and the phone call had to be ended. Harris-Speed provided a written statement to that effect.

Staff members on scene were asked if the described individual matched any of the employees that would have been working between November of 2022 and this date. None of the staff members provided an identity for the individual.

I contacted Sergeant Pruett and advised him of the information that had been gathered. I was advised to take all the information, contact the Crimes Against Children Division, and investigators would set up interview times on 01/09/2023.

I provided Little Creek Behavioral Health Center with the report number for this incident. I then contacted and advised her of the current situation. I provided her with the report number for this incident. A Crimes Against Children report was completed and submitted with number 2186625 assigned.
