On January 19, 2023, CACD Investigator Deidra Uselton interviewed [REDACTED] at Perimeter Behavioral Health. The following is a summary of Inv. Uselton's interview with [REDACTED]:

Inv. Uselton conducted a recorded forensic interview with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] began by talking about her interests and why she is at Perimeter and then discussed her family. [REDACTED] was asked why Inv. Uselton, and Det. Cardenas were here to speak with her today and she said because a girl sexually assaulted her. [REDACTED] was asked to talk about what happened from beginning to end. [REDACTED] said that she came to Perimeter on January 4th. She said she met a girl named [REDACTED] that was also a resident at Perimeter, and they began talking. [REDACTED] said they later became roommates and that was ok with her. [REDACTED] said that on Tuesday night they were in their room hanging out coloring and talking. [REDACTED] said she was talking about a sibling of hers tickling her and then [REDACTED] came up and began tickling her. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] began at her waist/hip area and was working her hands down to her who ha (pointed at vagina) but [REDACTED] denied that [REDACTED] touched her vagina. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] also touched her boobs on the clothes while tickling her. [REDACTED] said that before the tickling incident began [REDACTED] had told her she liked her and wanted them to be girlfriends. [REDACTED] said that in her head she was thinking "no way" but did not tell [REDACTED] that because she did not want to hurt her feelings. [REDACTED] said that when the incident happened, she was sitting on the bed and [REDACTED] was standing up in front of her and was moving closer to her as she was tickling her. [REDACTED] said she told [REDACTED] to stop, and she said, "no I like it." [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] did stop because she pushed her away and stood up. [REDACTED] said at this point she changed the subject and said let's color or go to bed and they ended up going to bed. [REDACTED] said she woke up first in the morning and went and told a staff member and she was moved out of [REDACTED] room around lunch. [REDACTED] denied that [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] to touch her anywhere on her body and she denied that [REDACTED] touched her anywhere else. [REDACTED] said she does still see [REDACTED] in class but as not had any issues and does not want to be her friend anymore. Inv. Uselton went over the other forms of maltreatment and [REDACTED] did not make a disclosure. [REDACTED] said she would tell her parents, school counselor, principal or SRO if something happened that was not ok.

On January 19, 2023 CACD Investigator Uselton and I, made contact with [REDACTED] at Perimeter Behavioral Health in Springdale. Inv. Uselton interviewed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] did not disclose any sexual assault allegations during her interview. [REDACTED] stated the alleged juvenile offender stopped tickling her when asked to stop. The alleged offender grazed her "boob" with her hand, and tickled her above her private area, but did not come in contact with her vagina.

The alleged offender is also a patient at Perimeter and is in foster care. We did not make contact with the alleged juvenile offender. Based on [REDACTED] disclosure, there is no evidence that a crime occurred. This case will be placed as inactive. I attached a copy of the recorded interview to the Tyler Case file.

I am forwarding this case to my supervisor for review.
