Primary Narrative By Dylan Burke, 01/25/23 17:28

Disturbance

On 1/25/2023 (Wednesday), at approximately 1728 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (Youth Home) in reference to a disturbance. Dispatch advised that two females are trying to fight staff members and another patient.

On arrival, I made contact with Deputy Tallent, Shelly Zellner and another staff who did not want to be identified. Deputy Tallent advised that all the girls involved in the incident were all separated in separate rooms. Shelly advised that [redacted] was antagonizing other patients all day. The other staff member advised that [redacted] called two patients ([redacted] and [redacted]) the "n-word" multiple times which caused [redacted] and [redacted] to get angry.

Shelly advised that [redacted] hit [redacted] in the face and [redacted] was in the background hyping up the fight. Shelly advised that staff members attempted to break up the fight and in the process, [redacted] bit staff member "Starkeisha Watkins" on the arm. The other staff member advised that Starkeisha was at the urgent care clinic seeking treatment and left before deputies' arrival.

Shelly advised in the midst of the incident that [redacted] bit patient "[redacted]" on the leg. Shelly and the other staff member advised that [redacted] is a psych, she is currently under their mental health treatment. [redacted] has started a new medication.

According to [redacted] face sheet provided by Shelly, [redacted] is diagnosed with Reactive, Attachment Disorder, Post-traumatic Stress Disorder, Unspecified Problem Related to Social Environment, Parent-Child Relational Problem, and Academic or Educational Problem.

I made phone contact with the Juvenile Intake Officer Elizabeth Mahan, I advised her what was stated above. Officer Mahan advised that she would be following up with Starkeisha at a later time to see if she wants to press charges. Due to the totality of the circumstances and [redacted] being treated under mental health professionals, charges were not pursued at this time.

I advised Shelly and other staff member of this. I provided Shelly with the report number and one to give to Starkeisha.
