## Primary Narrative By Jeremy Lawson, 02/20/23 18:18

### Information

On 2/20/2023 at approximately 1720 hours I responded to Colonel Glenn Youth Home INC. for a runaway juvenile report. Upon my arrival I began speaking with the staff members gathering information on [REDACTED] the juvenile who ran away from the home. The staff was able to tell me their location. I departed the scene and responded to the area where [REDACTED] was located and found him walking on the side of the road talking to the staff member. The staff member was driving in his POV. I stopped my patrol vehicle behind the car and exited my patrol vehicle. I was able to place [REDACTED] in my patrol vehicle without incident and took him back to Youth Home INC.. Upon our arrival back at the home the staff took custody of [REDACTED] and I departed the scene. I then advised dispatch that I would be back in service.
