BATTERY SECOND DEGREE-CERTAIN VICTIMS

On 2/24/2023, at 11:46 hours, I was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn in reference to a disturbance where two subjects had suffered injuries.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Youth Home staff, who advised me that _____ (offender) had assaulted two staff members and was currently cooling down in another room. I was advised by several staff members that the victims were in separate rooms and needing medical attention, at which time I requested that MEMS unit come to our location to treat injuries of both victims. After receiving a brief report of the altercation, I made contact with _____ and placed him into handcuffs. He was pat down for weapons and placed in the back of my patrol unit. At this time, Sgt. Simmons stood by my patrol unit and observed the offender while I went inside to make contact with both victims and Youth Home staff to gather further information.

I made contact with the first victim, Vincent Hunter. V. Hunter had a very large and noticeable knot above his left eye at the time of our interview. V. Hunter stated that on 2/23/2023, around 11:30 hours, he and the other victim, Stephen Webb, were tasked with restraining _____ and placing him into a small room that they frequently utilize for residents that need time to cool down. He advised that _____ had been angry because he was not allowed to get a library book and had been kicking the wall and causing a disturbance. V. Hunter advised that when he got into the room, he attempted to restrain him by placing him up against the wall and facing away from him. V. Hunter advised that while doing this, _____ threw his own head backward, striking V. Hunter in the head and causing a large knot to form above his left eye. V. Hunter advised that he and S. Webb continued to restrain _____ until he calmed down, at which time they contacted the Sheriff's office. Photos were taken of V. Hunter's injuries and uploaded to this report.

I then made contact with S. Webb in regards to the aforementioned incident. S. Webb advised the same story as V. Hunter and that he was attempting to restrain _____ and calm him down. S. Webb advised that while _____ was being held against the wall, that _____ swung his arm around and grabbed at S. Webb's face in an attempt to get away. S. Webb advised that when _____ swung his arm around, that he pulled on S. Webb's left ear, pulling the earring out of his ear lobe. I observed a small laceration to S. Webb's left ear. He advised that he continued to restrain _____ until he was able to calm down and deputies arrived. S. Webb advised that he has had dealings with _____ in the past and described him as a good but troubled kid. Photos were taken of S. Webb's injuries and

uploaded to this report.

I spoke to management staff at the Youth Home and was advised that they already had a treatment plan in place and were requesting that [redacted] be transported to Children's Hospital so that he could be put into an acute care facility. It was reiterated several times that they did not wish [redacted] to be charged and taken to jail and were hopeful that he could simply be taken to the hospital prior to being put into a different facility that would more adequately meet his needs. [redacted] was described by several individuals as a good kid but with a troubled past who was in need of additional help that could not be provided in their facility.

I then made contact with [redacted]. Post Miranda, [redacted] advised that he did, in fact, throw his head back while attempting to avoid being restrained, striking V. Hunter. He further advised that he inadvertently pulled S. Webb's earring out of his ear when he was wildly throwing his arms around. Photographs were taken of [redacted] and [redacted] and uploaded to this report.

At this time, I spoke with Sgt. Nutt and briefed him on the situation. Due to Youth Home staff requesting he be taken for additional medical treatment as opposed to incarceration and taking into account his current demeanor along with details of his situation that led him to be placed into Youth Home, it was determined that he would be transported to Children's Hospital via MEMS to be referred to an acute care facility.

[redacted] was then taken out of handcuffs and MEMS unit 608 transported [redacted] to Children's Hospital.

Both victims were given a report number and Youth Home staff advised that they were aware of the warrant process should they later decide to pursue charges.

All parties were advised to contact PCSO with any further information.
