Licensing Narrative: Licensing specialist followed up with DON Ana and therapist Madelyn about this resident's frequent self-harm behaviors during an unannounced building and grounds/complaint visit. Therapist Madelyn stated that this resident has chronic self-harm behaviors that have not increased or changed, therefore, it is the judgment of the clinical team that an acute referral is not appropriate at this time. They

continue to closely monitor the situation and keep resident on LOS and self-harm precautions. Facility has also implemented a no plastic policy on the units due to these incidents. Licensing specialist viewed LOS documentation and safety plan for resident. Licensing specialist viewed resident's unit and checked resident's room for obvious hazards/contraband. The screw that was loose in her window has been fixed. No contraband/dangerous materials identified in her room or on her unit day of visit. Resident was observed to be sitting in the day room with an MHP and several other residents at time of visit.
