RN arrived and was able to intervene and take resident from the unit to a quieter area in the milieu. Mild bleeding noted around nose requiring no first aid. Resident washed face and hands with soap and water. Nose examined after being washed; no injury apparent. Resident was able to regulate emotions and return to unit without further incident. [REDACTED] will be placed on a self-harm precaution safety plan with increased line of sight as a result of this event. If you have any questions, please let me know.

Licensing Narrative: Licensing specialist sent email to DON Ana Salzar asking if any nursing and/or therapeutic interventions are currently in place to address resident's self-

harm behaviors. Ms. Salzar advised that resident has been placed on self-harm precautions, constant LOS, and facility is working to re-direct behaviors. Licensing specialist will follow up with resident's therapist at next unannounced visit, planned for 01/19/2023, to view safety plan and determine if there are any specific therapy goals/interventions in place to address resident self-harm behaviors. 01/19/2023: resident remains on constant LOS precautions, facility is working on identifying specific interventions.
