521 Visit Compliance Report

All units within ratio at time of visit, all residents were observed to be within LOS of staff members at time of visit. Ratios: Green 2:9, Orange 2:10, Classroom 1 3:8. Licensing specialist viewed all bedrooms and dayrooms on each unit and there were no safety hazards noted. The tiles in bathroom of room 205 have been repaired, and the tiles in showers of room 305 have been repaired. The grounds remain out of use until the roofing project is completed on the building due to the presence of contraband materials such as nails and sharp sheet metal.

Licensing specialist observed classroom 1 engaged in an activity with the facility activity coordinator. Monthly activity calendar not available at time of visit because activity director was out most of the week with the inclement weather. However, facility provided a list of activities that were provided to residents this week including exercise groups, therapy groups, arts and crafts, and team building exercises.

Facility provided a list of all new hires for month of January 2023 as per CAA requirements and confirmed that they are no longer using temporary staffing agencies.

Licensing specialist followed up regarding recent facility self-reports of self-harm incidents: resident been placed on a detailed, individualized, signed, safety contract which outlines interventions and for self-harm behaviors and incentives for safe behaviors that was developed with her input. Interventions include 1:1 while in the classroom, regular room searches, and processing using grounding activities. disclosed to facility staff that she has been hiding contraband in a very narrow gap between her bed and the wall (bed is bolted to the floor and does not move). The gap is too small for a hand to fit through, so she was sliding a folder in the gap to retrieve items. Staff has used a rod to remove all contraband items from the gap and are implementing regular room searches on the units. CEO is in process of training all staff on how to complete a thorough room search. The other incidents of self-harm, which primarily involved fingernail scratches are being addressed by staff re-training on de-escalation and continued programmatic changes to ensure residents are engaged throughout the day. There is also a standing order to trim and cut resident fingernails as needed.
