While in the gym courtyard the resident stated he found a small piece of glass and swallowed it. Actions Taken: Resident was assessed by nursing and APRN then sent out to FCMC for further evaluation. The resident returned to the facility with a diagnosis of: Suicidal ideation; foreign body in mouth, initial encounter. The resident returned to the facility, and it was noted that the resident never swallowed the glass. The resident was placed on suicide precautions and line of sight precautions for safety. Precautions are reassessed every 24 hours until the resident is deemed safe. The resident stated that he is having these ideations due to his upcoming discharge. He stated he does not want to leave the facility because he's afraid he will mess up while at home. On-call maintenance staff came to the facility on 2/10/23 at 8pm to vacuum all outside window seals to ensure no more plexi glass particles were left from the previous window fix. Staff will continue to monitor the residents' progress while in the milieu and in school. Guardianship: OH Foster Care

Mr. Williams informed Licensing Specialist that resident gestured that he swallowed something. Mr. Williams reported that the resident held the object in his mouth but never swallowed it. Mr. Williams informed Licensing Specialist that the resident was taken to FCMC for further evaluation because it could not be determined if resident swallowed anything.

Licensing Specialist, Ms. Lockhart, and Mr. Williams discussed the incident. Ms. Lockhart informed Licensing Specialist that the camera on the courtyard is scheduled to be repaired. Licensing Specialist was informed that resident is still on precautions.
