Report Description: I wanted to inform you of an incident that occurred at The Centers (Destiny House) on 3/03/2023. On 3/03/2023, client , DOB: began to verbalize homicidal and suicidal thoughts. began kicking doors and hitting walls. Staff members attempted to verbally redirect but were from harming himself or others, he was placed in unsuccessful. To keep several Emergency Safety Interventions (ESIs) and was given an IM injection over the course of several hours. The Centers Medical Team determined, to keep safe, was transported to Arkansas Children?s he would need a higher level of care. Hospital (ACH) by MEMS for further evaluation for his homicidal/suicidal thoughts. ACH is attempting to locate an acute placement for but have been unsuccessful. At s guardian was notified about the time of this report, is at ACH. is a DCFS placement at The Centers. Licensing Specialist reviewed camera footage for a provider reported incident. Licensing Specialist also reviewed documentation (physician orders, staff, and nursing notes).

Licensing Specialist observed resident being aggressive toward staff, trying to charge at a peer, and being restrained. Licensing Specialist heard resident asking for shots. Throughout the camera footage review, ratio varied from 4:1, 5:1, and 6:1.

Licensing Specialist observed residents being removed from the day area due to the resident's behavior. Licensing Specialist also observed resident being removed from the day area. Licensing Specialist observed resident walking around the day area with staff supervision. Licensing Specialist was unable to see resident kicking/hitting the walls and doors but heard sounds of the door and walls being kicked/hit.

Licensing Specialist observed resident being restrained at different times throughout the camera footage review. Resident tried to charge at a peer, he was being aggressive toward staff, and he was observed reaching for things to throw/destroy but was intervened by staff. Licensing Specialist observed a nurse on the phone before each chemical restraint was given. Licensing Specialist did not observe any licensing concerns on the emergency safety interventions or IM injections.

Mr. Knowles, Compliance Officer, informed Licensing Specialist that that resident did not verbalize a plan. Licensing Specialist informed that resident is still at Arkansas Children's Hospital. Before this incident, resident was scheduled to discharge on 3/10/2023.
