Phone call made to facility 3/9/23 to determine that client is AR Foster Care client and to confirm that camera footage of this incident is available. Facility visited 3/9/23 and camera footage reviewed of Boys' Hall from the evening of 3/7/23. At 7:50PM client is seen stepping half-way out of her (client identifies as female) room and stating, "I'm killing myself right now". What appears to be a sock is wrapped around her neck. No staff are seen in the hallway at the time says this. Another client immediately goes to get staff who within less than a minute enters the room. Another staff is seen assisting and standing in the hallway. Staff is then seen pulling on the floor out of her room. Staff has ahold of s shirt and drags down the hall and places against the wall. Additional staff and nurse are then seen assisting seems to deescalate without further incident. Later in the evening was taken to Methodist Acute Hospital. No staff were seen in Boys' Hall at the time client made the suicidal comment. Dragging client by her shirt on the floor was not a safe escort. Facility cited 907.2,907.3 and 101.9g. On 3/7/23 at 7:50pm client (male client who identifies as female) was trying to attempt to inflict self-harm. If tied socks together and then wrapped around her neck. Staff noticed what was happening, came into the room to remove the socks from around in neck, and take is out of her room. Was crying and screaming I want to die. The doctor was notified and was sent to the Methodist Acute Hospital.

Facility visited 3/9/23 and camera footage reviewed of Boys' Hall from the evening of 3/7/23. At 7:50PM client is seen stepping half-way out of her (client identifies as female) room and stating, "I'm killing myself right now". What appears to be a sock is wrapped around her neck. No staff are seen in the hallway at the time is says this. Another client immediately goes to get staff is seen assisting and standing who within less than a minute enters the room. Another staff is seen assisting and standing in the hallway. Staff is then seen pulling on the floor out of her room. Staff is a shold of is shirt and drags down the hall and places against the wall. Additional staff and nurse are then seen assisting is seens to deescalate without further incident. Later in the evening was taken to Methodist Acute Hospital.

No staff were seen in Boys' Hall at the time client made the suicidal comment. Dragging client by her shirt on the floor was not a safe escort.

Provider Comments:

Our plan of action will include a review of the video regarding the incident with the staff member. She will attend the next available CPI class. She will also receive a written warning regarding professionalism.
