Report Description: On 3/7/23 at 7:50pm [REDACTED], age [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] was trying to attempt to inflict self-harm. [REDACTED] tied socks together and then wrapped around his neck. Staff noticed what was happening, came into the room to remove the socks from around [REDACTED] neck, and take [REDACTED] out of his room. [REDACTED] was crying and screaming I want to die. The doctor was notified and [REDACTED] was sent to the acute hospital.

The doctor was notified and [REDACTED] was sent to the acute hospital. Email sent to facility 3/9/23 to save camera footage. Phone call made to facility 3/9/23 to determine that

client is AR Foster Care client and to confirm that camera footage of this incident is available. Facility visited 3/9/23 and camera footage reviewed of Boys' Hall from the evening of 3/7/23. At 7:50PM client [REDACTED] is seen stepping half-way out of her (client [REDACTED] identifies as female) room and stating, "I'm killing myself right now". What appears to be a sock is wrapped around her neck. No staff are seen in the hallway at the time [REDACTED] says this. Another client immediately goes to get staff [REDACTED] who within less than a minute enters the room. Another staff is seen assisting and standing in the hallway. Staff [REDACTED] is then seen pulling [REDACTED] on the floor out of her room. Staff [REDACTED] has ahold of [REDACTED]'s shirt and drags [REDACTED] down the hall and places [REDACTED] against the wall. Additional staff and nurse are then seen assisting [REDACTED] seems to deescalate without further incident. Later in the evening [REDACTED] was taken to Methodist Acute Hospital. No staff were seen in Boys' Hall at the time client [REDACTED] made the suicidal comment. Dragging client [REDACTED] by her shirt on the floor was not a safe escort. Facility cited 907.2,907.3 and 101.9g. Licensing Specialist made report to the [REDACTED] for possible [REDACTED] ref# [REDACTED] The report was screened out.
