Provider Comments:

In response to supervision, staff child ratio was appropriate. Staff immediately intervened to break up fight. Staff should have called for assistance sooner as well as had a walkie talkie in order to immediately call for assistance as the situation escalated. Staff will be retrained on what could have been differently.
