Staff interviewed and broke the fight up and got client [REDACTED] off of the unit to separate the two clients. A [REDACTED] was called and the referral number is [REDACTED]. It was not accepted. Staff should have called for assistance sooner as well as had a walkie talkie in order to immediately call for assistance as the situation escalated. Staff will be retrained on what could have been differently.
