Report Description: Name: [REDACTED] DOB: [REDACTED], Notified: Amber Winters (TX/DHS) On 3/12/23 at approximately 1720, [REDACTED] became dysregulated on the unit because of being triggered by a peer and used her fingernail to reopen superficial abrasions that were already in the stages of healing. This caused minimal bleeding that was wiped clean by RN. RN then processed 1:1 with [REDACTED] and she contracted to safety. Because of this event, she will continue to be on self-harm precautions with constant line of sight until safe behaviors are displayed.

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Licensing Narrative: Visited facility today. [REDACTED] was in the classroom interacting with peers. The classroom was in ratio. "[REDACTED]" got up and addressed licensing specialist at doorway wanted to know why "[licensing specialist] was messing with us with all these rules and trying to make us look bad." ADON calmly and appropriately asked her to return to class and advised that one individual DHS worker does not have anything to do with

making the rules. ■" returned to her seat and continued to interact with the other students, laughing and joking. She was within LOS of staff at time of visit and there was no evidence that she was in distress. No additional licensing follow up is required at this time.
