When she came to get her AM medication, she refused to return to the unit and when asked to elaborate on what upset her, she began to attempt to tie her paper scrubs that she was wearing around her neck. This was quickly removed by RN and therapist. She then began to attempt to hit herself in the head with her fist to which she was physically blocked. She was eventually able to regulate her emotions with the help of staff and her therapist. There were no injuries sustained in relation to this incident. Because of this event, resident will remain on suicide and self-harm precautions with constant line of sight until safe behavior is displayed.

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Licensing Narrative: Unannounced licensing visit walk through today. Resident is currently restricted to unit and was completing schoolwork at a desk within LOS of 2 staff members.

She was wearing paper scrubs. She spoke with administrator and licensing specialist as we were walking through, and her manner was calm and appropriate. Staff were observed interacting with the residents on unit restriction in a calm and appropriate manner. No need for additional licensing follow up at this time.
