Resident taken out to comfort room for safety. [REDACTED] was observed putting hands around neck attempting to choke themselves several times, as well as, digging nails into skin in an attempt to break the skin and ?get to the vein.? Small circular breaks in the skin noted from resident picking at skin with fingernails. Redness with minimal bleeding noted. No first aid required. No redness on neck noted. Crisis interventionist and therapist brought in for support. [REDACTED] was eventually able to self-regulate and processed 1:1 with DON/ADON and returned to unit without further incident. Resident agreed to take AM medications. C-SSRS scale preformed, resident scores high risk for suicide. Suicide and self-harm precautions now in place. Resident placed in paper scrubs for safety. Will continue to assess with C-SSRS scale once per shift.

Interim Action Narrative: Redness with minimal bleeding noted, no first aid required. Crisis interventionist and therapist were brought in for support. Resident was able to self-regulate and processed 1:1 with DON and ADON. Resident returned to her unit without further incident. S

Licensing Narrative: Licensing Specialist will inquire about the door frame and the unit of the resident. Licensing Specialist will schedule a visit to review camera footage. On 11/23/2022, Time of Visit: 10:14 am to 12:30 pm Census: 24 Licensing Specialist reviewed camera footage for the 11/15/2022 provider reported incident. Licensing Specialist observed other residents leaving the unit to go to class. Resident () was left on the unit and Licensing Specialist observed resident and staff what appeared to be processing, ration 2:1. Resident was observed crawling around on the floor trying to find things but was blocked by staff. Resident was observed trying to bang her head on the floor but was blocked by staff and holding her arms to prevent resident from banging her head. Licensing Specialist was informed that this incident took place on the Green Unit. Resident was observed refusing her medication but later took her medication. Licensing Specialist inquired about the door frame that resident attempted to self-harm. Licensing Specialist observed and touched the rounded screws on the door frame. Licensing Specialist felt no rough edges and was not scratched when rubbing hand and wrist across the rounded screws. No licensing concerns noted.
