?s right hand and noted his pinky finger was slightly swollen. An ice pack was
applied to the injured finger, but was non-compliant with keeping the ice
pack on. Dr. Bowling was notified and instructed the nursing staff to re-evaluate the pinky
finger the following morning (11/23/2022). On 11/23/2022,
again assessed and medical personnel noted swelling to the finger and
reported feeling some pain. Out of an abundance of caution, the APRN gave the order to
send to Ortho Arkansas for further evaluation. was
