Staff/client ratio for 11/24/22 was 2 nurses + 7 staff/24 clients. and seen in a hallway. is seen discharging a fire extinguisher in a hallway, 1 staff seen and 1 staff heard in audio. Video viewed from inside Dorm 1. Dorm 1 staff/client ratio seen to be 1:5. Staff let and into Dorm 1, seeing fire extinguisher discharge in hallway. Dorm 1's emergency exit does not exit within fence line; it exits directly into the parking lot. Dorm 1 staff open emergency exit. and seen walking through the parking lot with 2 staff, staff attempting to provide barriers to and eloping. 2 additional staff are seen joining parking lot. and are seen walking out of camera view, staff following. Facility self-report indicates that staff never lost sight of clients. and were transported back to facility by LRPD. Video reviewed of police cruiser returning clients at about 1917. No licensing concerns from camera footage viewed.
