Report Description: I wanted to inform you of an incident that occurred at The Centers (EMAC) on 12/04/2022. On 12/04/2022, at approximately 1816 hours, staff called medical personnel for client [REDACTED] ([REDACTED], DOB: [REDACTED]) because [REDACTED] was not responding to verbal stimuli. Centers medical personnel responded and immediately began to assess [REDACTED]. Medical personnel noted [REDACTED] was alert but unresponsive verbally. [REDACTED]'s vitals fluctuated during her medical assessment, and she was breathing rapidly. Centers Medical Director, Dr. Bowling, was contacted and gave instructions to call MEMS and have [REDACTED] transported to Arkansas Children's Hospital (ACH) for further evaluation. Once at ACH, medical personnel there treated [REDACTED] for a behavior disturbance (anxiety). [REDACTED] was released from ACH and transported back to EMAC at approximately 0430 hours (12/05/22).
