Licensing Specialist informed that daily maintenance walk throughs are conducted by the Maintenance Supervisor and Director of Quality and Risk Management. 1/6/2023, Licensing Specialist and Director of Quality and Risk Management discussed the prevention plan for when residents are in the classrooms.

track. Another resident reported to staff he found two staples and swallowed them. X-ray revealed no foreign bodies.

Licensing Specialist was informed that teachers have been made aware for staples to be kept out of view of the residents. Licensing Specialist was also informed that residents are not allowed behind or around the teachers' desk.

Licensing Specialist and Ms. Coplin discussed how her and the Maintenance Lead complete daily walk-throughs of the facility. Licensing Specialist was informed that Education has black tape on the floor to mark how close residents are allowed to the teacher's desk. Licensing Specialist will follow-up with facility on 1/13/2023 to make sure that each classroom is marked.
