Licensing Specialist observed a staff member standing against a wall with residents walking around on the hallway, ratio 1:3. Licensing Specialist observed residents walking up to staff and what appeared to be a gesture of playing around. Licensing Specialist observed staff trying to prevent the residents from getting too close to him. Residents were observed grabbing on staff and staff falling to the ground. Staff's key fob was taken, and residents ran off the hallway into the administration part of the building and out the door. Second Elopement ? Licensing Specialist observed residents walking around in the dayroom. Licensing Specialist was unable to view when and who kicked the door open due to the view of the camera. Licensing Specialist did observe the residents running through the administration building. Licensing Specialist was informed there were no damages to the doors. Licensing Specialist corresponded with Ms. Banks via email regarding the residents' precautions. Residents were put on strict unit restriction (24/7 supervision). Residents were also placed on strict elopement precautions and strict assault precautions.

Licensing Specialist did observe the residents running through the administration building. Licensing Specialist was informed there were no damages to the doors.
