Police were called: N/A Resident picking and scratching at her arm with nails. She then ripped off a piece of her shirt and used it to wrap around her neck. Staff were able to remove the fabric and gave to RN. Upon assessment resident has a very blunted affect and no emotional response to conversation. AOx4 no deviations from mental baseline. Resident has a reddened area around her neck from this. Resident admitted that she wanted to hurt herself and agreed to wear paper scrubs. Staff processing with resident. CSSRS completed resident scored high risk. Residents will be on suicide precautions for 7 days. Will continue to monitor.

Licensing Narrative: Licensing reviewed this incident and followed up in person on 12/29/22. A discussion took place with the DON Ana Salazar as to why the resident was not taken and assessed for self-harm if she was considered a "high risk" at the time of this incident. The DON explained that the attempts were believed to be in response to the resident not being able to reach her parents on the phone for the holidays. The resident was upset at the time, but once she was able to get ahold of her parents, she has not had another self-harm event.
