Notice of Serious Incident

Report Description: **Construction** (**Construction**, Parent Custody, DOB: **Operation**) entered the supervisor office of Kangaroo Hall without permission and unbeknownst to staff. She obtained a pair of scissors and brought them to her room, violating her established Safety Plan. Stemming from a negative interaction with a peer, she was found to be using them to self-harm. On-site nursing care provided. Nurse notes: Patient reopened wound to left arm and cut gashes into left hand. Wounds were cleaned and wrapped with gauze. Sent for assessment at Dallas County Medical Center ER. No further treatment was deemed necessary for injuries. Follow Up: For the severity of her self-injurious behavior, was referred to Conway Behavioral Health acute placement. She was transported by Millcreek and discharged into CBH custody without incident. Supervisory personnel performed staff in-services on patient supervision and securing doors where patient entry is prohibited.

Licensing Narrative: On 12/29/22 client obtained a pair of scissors and selfharmed. Client was taken to the ER and treated for injuries. Client was referred and transferred to Conway Behavioral Health. 12/30/22- Program Coordinator reviewed the incident as the assigned licensing specialist is on leave. The Program Coordinator emailed Chris Butler to ask if any video footage was available for review and the names of the staff who were responsible for the resident's care at the time of the incident. Received email from facility that staff responsible for supervising client at the time of the injury were and that there is video footage of the incident. Facility visited and 1/3/23 in response to incident. Physician orders for client from 12/20/22 until incident reviewed. Therapist' note/Plan of Safe Care from 12/20/22 reviewed. Client placed on 72-hour unit restriction starting 12/20/22. Client discharged from unit restriction before this incident occurred. Client continued on CO (close observation) and EP (elopement precautions) as client was a new admit. Client was on CO and EP when incident occurred. Video reviewed from the incident on 12/29/22. Client is seen leaving group, walking down the hall and noticing staff office is open. Client then enters and exits office. Client then enters her room. Client is seen being observed by staff 11 minutes later without incident. 29 minutes after this, two clients are seen looking into client s room and running to get staff. It is at this point that staff reportedly notice client has been injured. Facility policy is staff offices remained locked at all times when staff are not present. Facility cited 907.2 and 910.1. Facility indicated that and are to be retrained on securing offices/supervision. Chris Butler stated during today's visit that proof of this training would be sent to licensing upon receipt.
