Report Description: I wanted to inform you of an incident that occurred at The Centers (EMAC) on 12/29/2022. On 12/29/2022, client [REDACTED] ([REDACTED], DOB: 0[REDACTED]) became dysregulated and was verbally and physically abusive towards staff. [REDACTED] made statements that she would harm herself and others. Centers medical personnel made the decision to seek acute placement for [REDACTED] in order to keep her [REDACTED] and others safe. On 12/29/22, at approximately 1933 hours, Centers staff transported [REDACTED] to an acute facility, Conway Behavioral Health, where she could receive a higher level of care. [REDACTED] did not sustain any injuries because of this incident. [REDACTED]'s guardian was notified about this incident. [REDACTED] is a DCFS placement at The Centers. Interim Action Narrative: Resident did not sustain any injuries and was transported to acute care.

Licensing Narrative: Licensing Specialist will follow-up with the facility on resident's verbal and physical aggression toward staff. Licensing Specialist informed no staff were injured during this incident. 1/5/2023, Licensing Specialist requested witness statements and nursing notes. 1/9/2023, resident was transported to acute placement due to threatening self-harm and threatening others. 1/10/2023, Licensing Specialist informed resident was discharged from the facility to continue with higher level of care.
