Nursing Assessment date/time 02/22/23 1:25pm: Pt has been assessed by nursing and Dr. Shy. After Zofran pt continues to vomit. Unable to hold down clear liquids. Pts pallor is pale, states that he feels shaky on the inside and like he is going to pass out. Pt has not eaten or drink since 3 to 11 shift last night other than a few sips of sprite that he vomited up immediately. Assisted pt. into a rolling chair and out to the van to be transported to ACH ER Guardian was notified on 02/22/23 at 4:46pm
