Report Description: On 10/25/22 at 8:14 pm on the girl's unit foyer, [REDACTED] and client [REDACTED] had an altercation. A verbal altercation began between the two, and then [REDACTED] walked into [REDACTED] personal space and a push was initiated by staff. [REDACTED] then tried to attack and hit [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] tried to block and grab [REDACTED] arm from striking her. [REDACTED] tried to initiate a restraint but was unsuccessful. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] fell into the couch area where [REDACTED] fell to the floor. [REDACTED] let go of [REDACTED] as soon as she touched the floor, and other staff came to assist. When the other staff assisted, [REDACTED] tapped out. A [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and not accepted. The referral number is [REDACTED]. The correction action plan for this incident is an in-service on the correct CPI holds, personal space between staff and clients, a write-up about voice tone/language towards clients, move the staff from the girl's floor to the boy's floor.

[REDACTED] immediately after this visit and reported this incident to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] could not confirm that the call had been accepted or not. A callback # was provided. Provider Comments:

After the incident was reviewed the [REDACTED] was contacted. The call was not accepted. The Consultant call Licensing and reported the incident. The staff member was moved to the first floor. The staff member was provided additional training on CPI, de-escalation techniques, and proximate space. She is enrolled in a CPI refresher course on 11/8. She will receive a written warning. She will also receive a Performance Improvement Plan.
